Inaugural Event April 19, 2017

Improving Project Outcomes is a collaborative initiative that strives to facilitate better results for projects within the state. AIA of PA, COAA of PA, DBIA, and KCA have teamed up with a similar interest to establish a commitment to create meaningful conversations on design and construction excellence. During April of 2017, this group held their first Improving Project Outcomes event at the Appalachian Brewing Co. in Harrisburg. Some major topics discussed included: pull planning, early collaboration, legislation reform, design and construction challenges, and current industry trends. This event allowed small breakout groups to separate and collaborate to discuss the best practices. Attendance was great with over 50 people representing roughly 35 companies.



At the end of the event, questions were asked regarding what went well. The top three responses were having the

four groups in attendance (KCA, DBIA, AIA, COAA), having a desire to change, and a diverse range of attendees. Having representatives from the hosting groups enabled real discussions on real topics. Not only does their attendance maximize

efficiency, but the groups were also able to take advantage of the diverse perspectives. Their

differences in view points gave this event a wider range of insight to tackle discussion topics. Facilitating change is one objective that Improving Project Outcomes ventures toward.
